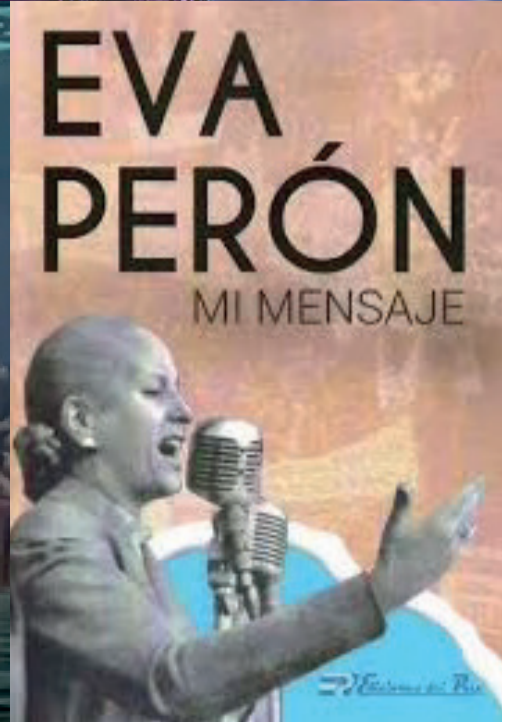
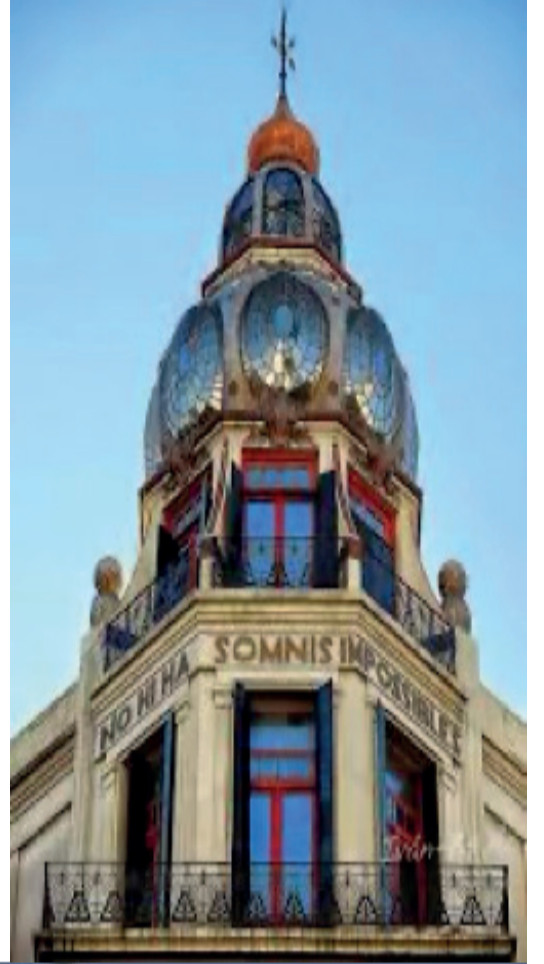

## 2026

- Open to all learners of Spanish enrolled in an A-level, IB (or equivalent) course.
- Winners to be selected by the Bulletin of Advanced Spanish editorial team, announced and published in the autumn edition.
- The essay may be on any topic rooted in the Spanish-speaking world. If in doubt, check with us before you start writing.
- Entries should not overlap with subject matter previously covered in articles published in the Bulletin (our Index and Past Editions pages will enable entrants to comply with this requirement). For example, an essay about the overthrow of Maduro in Venezuela might cover similar ground to articles in our Spring 2026 edition; however, an essay about corruption under Maduro, or Maduro's alleged links to drug trafficking would be acceptable, given that those two topics have not previously been covered.
- Word count: 750 - 900 words
- BAS is a bilingual publication, so entries may be in either English or Spanish.
